



Tournament Information

Welcome to the 4th Annual Bradford Bulldogs Blue & Gold Classic Hockey Tournament @ The Beautiful [Nottawasaga Resort](#) in Alliston, Ontario Jan 20-22, 2012. Most games will take place at [The Centre Ice Sportsplex](#) located on The Resort while games will also be held at [Bob Fallis Recreation Centre](#), [Bradford Community Centre](#), [New Tecumseh Recreation Centre](#), [Innisfil Recreation Complex](#) & [Lefroy South Innisfil Community Centre](#).

Tournament will consist of 9 divisions:

Atom House B
Peewee House B
Peewee House A/ Select
Minor Bantam House A/ Select
Minor Midget House B
Minor Midget **Contact**
Midget House A/ Select
Midget LL **Contact**
Midget House B

Note: All divisions are non-body checking except the Minor Midget & Midget LL Contact divisions

Format of Tournament:

- Maximum of 3, 4, 5, 6, 8 or 10 teams per division. Each team is guaranteed at least 3 games.
- Maximum of 17 players and 2 goalies may be registered per team. A maximum of 17 players plus 2 goalies can be dressed per game. Players can only register & play in one division.
- In the 3 team division all teams are guaranteed 3 games. Top team gets a bye to final after the first 2 games. The other 2 teams play a semi final with winner playing in the final.
- In the 4 team divisions a round robin format will be done. Top 2 teams in the division will play in the Championship Final Sunday.
- In the 5 team division, all teams are guaranteed 4 games. The top 2 teams will play on Championship Sunday
- In the 6 team division the top 2 teams will play in the Championship Final Sunday.
- In the 8 team division there will be (2) divisions of 4 teams, with the top 2 teams in each division advancing to a semi final. Winner of Pool I will play 2nd place team in Pool II. 2nd place team in Pool I will play winner of Pool II. Winners of semi finals will play in championship game.
- In the 10 team division, all teams are guaranteed 4 games. There are 2 pools set up where all teams in each pool play each other. The top team in each pool plays on Championship Sunday.
- ****All teams will play 1-2 games Friday with 1-2 games Saturday. Semi Finals & Finals all take place on Championship Sunday!***

Further Information:

- Teams **MUST** present Approved Team Roster Sheets & Travel Permits or Letter of Permissions
- Coaching staff will be required to register 60 minutes before 1st game & 45 minutes prior to other games. Please have your team ready to play 15-30 minutes prior to your game time if necessary. This doesn't apply to the first game of the day!
- Tournament Committee will designate home teams unless designated on schedule
- Home teams will wear a light colour jersey. If a conflict arises regarding jersey colours, the VISITING team will change jerseys.(conflict sweaters will also be available at tournament office)
- Players & Coaches must be in their dressing rooms 30 minutes prior to their game time.
- Dressing rooms must be vacated within 20 minutes of game completion.
- A 3 minute warm-up will be allowed after the ice is cleaned. Clock will be start at 13 minutes. At the 11 minute mark, TIMEKEEPER WILL BUZZ CLOCK & TEAMS WILL HAVE ONE MINUTE TO GATHER PUCKS & BE READY OTHERWISE CLOCK MAY RUN UNTIL REFEREES DROP PUCK. Players will shake hands at beginning of game.

Tournament Rules

- OMHA Rules will apply
- Games will consist of 3 x 10 minute periods stop time. If there is a 4 goal spread in the 3rd period, clock will run in the last 5 minutes. If goal spread goes back to 3, clock will stop. Only for round robin games.
- No timeouts in round robin play. One (30 second) timeout will be allowed for each team in the Championship Game.
- 2 Points for win, 1 point for a tie, 0 points for a loss

Tie Breakers

In the event of a tie in the standings, the final results will be decided by:

- a) Results of their head to head game (win or loss) Applies for round robin games. **If 3 or more teams tied go to b).**
 - b) Most total wins
 - c) Goal differential. The team with the highest tournament goal average. This is determined by the total goals scored/ total goals for & against. EXAMPLE: Team 1 scores 10 goals and gives up 14. $10/24=.417$ PLEASE NOTE MAXIMUM GOAL DIFFERENTIAL IN ANY GAME IS 7 GOALS.
 - d) Least amount of penalty minutes
 - e) Most goals scored
 - f) Fewest goals allowed
 - g) In a 6 team division, first tie breaker will not include a) unless the 2 teams that are tied have played each other.
 - h) For Championship & Semi Final games in case of a tie, there will be a 4 on 4 3 minute running time period. Last 30 seconds stop time. If still tied, a 3 on 3, 3 minute running time period, last 30 seconds stop time. If still tied, a 2 on 2, 3 minute running time period, last 30 seconds stop time. If still tied a 1 on 1, 3 minute running time period, last 30 seconds stop time will occur. If still tied the 1 on 1 format still applies until someone scores.
- Game Forfeits will result in a 1-0 win.

- A major fighting or gross misconduct penalty will result in player suspension from tournament.
- Any team official (coach, trainer or manager) ejected from a game will also be suspended for the remainder of the tournament.
- Coaches are responsible for team conduct while their team is at the Arena.
- Any disputes will be settled by the Tournament Committee and all decisions will be final
